Enrollment

We received and accepted the following proposal from the District regarding the balancing period:

The District proposes an extension of 5 days to the 12-day enrollment period for year-round schools (July 30,2024). This would allow for additional time to identify/redirect placements, establish/confirm transportation routes and notify sites/staff and families.

The team continues to meet and advocate for adhering to the contract both its language and intent as well as limiting the number of combos. In cases where there are any exceptions, members of the team would speak to the impacted teachers and create provisions for the teacher - the team is concentrating on Year Rounds at this time.

AT&T Outages

While we appreciate the responses from the District related to the AT&T outages, we have shared that ALL hotspot requests need to be honored. There were some folks who worked at 2 sites and they were given hotspots at the one site but not the other. We had also heard that the DO continued to have full power and learned that it is because they are in the same grid as the police headquarters - which has backup protocols so they are not left without power related to AT&T.

Chromebooks

There is a new practice that ultimately requires teachers K-6 to enter/re-enter student id and passwords and provide general set up for the Chromebooks for each of their students. We have asked the District why the change and shared that it requires at least a prep period to enter the information. Since the prep time use is supposed to be determined by the teacher (not by circumstances created by the district) we have asked for reimbursement of lost prep, collaboration time, or after-hours time dedicated to inputting information. We have also asked that the District revert to the former practice whereby the Chromebook "follows" the student. We are waiting for their response.

Transitional Kinder

We are still working on some outstanding TK issues related to the MOU- we hope to bring forward an agreement soon!

Evaluation Timeline
