May 8th School Board Meeting

Join us at the next HUSD Board of Education meeting on May 8th at 6:30pm to show the solidarity and strength of the union and encourage the HUSD Board of Trustees to approve our contract. While we don't anticipate issues with the ratification by the board, a strong voice and presence at the meeting will bring that much more of an impact of the importance of this tentative agreement to improve our working lives as educators, and improve the quality of education we provide to our students.

<u> Calendar Bargaining Survey – Last Call!</u>

Calendar surveys and voting went out to all members' personal email addresses earlier this week. If you did not receive it (and after checking your spam folder to confirm that you did not receive it), please email <u>office@heahayward.org</u> asap! Voting will **close on Monday**, **May 6**, **at 4:00pm**.

For Year Round and Traditional Calendars, if you take the surveys/votes you will have a strong sense as to what the calendars will be. For **Preschool** (both traditional and year round calendars), all of the holidays and start/end dates are in place but we are still in bargaining on preschool changes and will complete calendars once bargaining is completed. We are also waiting for completion of negotiations on extended year preschool to create the extended year calendar. We are working on Adult school calendars and will be using staff input to complete negotiations as quickly as possible.

A Change to How the Community Elects Our Board Members

The Hayward Unified School District (HUSD) is changing the way that voters elect our school board members and it is important to understand what is happening and why. As the District would like as much community involvement in the process as possible, especially with this short redistricting timeline, they have asked for help in sharing this information with HEA members.

The District currently utilizes an "at-large" election system where voters from the entire school district elect all five Trustees. HUSD is moving to a "by-district" election system in which the **school district is divided into five separate electoral districts**, and where voters select Trustees for their respective districts. <u>See the attached District memo that was recently sent to HEA for more information</u>.

This change will take effect starting with the 2026 Board of Education election.

Hayward Collegiate

We need your help to identify and recruit colleagues and parents from your sites to oppose the charter expansion and lobby the Alameda Board of Education to oppose their request.

Hayward Collegiate is a K-6 charter school in Hayward owned by Navigator Schools, which operates several charter schools in the Bay Area. Hayward Collegiate currently enrolls 240 students. Under their proposed expansion, future enrollment would grow to 580 students and add grades 7-8 to their school.

Hayward Unified is already facing declining enrollment and other budget pressures that have resulted in two schools closing in 2022 (Bowman and Strobridge) and the loss of 50 FTE teaching positions for the 2024-2025 school year. The loss of additional students to Hayward Collegiate would deprive HUSD of more than \$5 million, resulting in additional cuts and closures that would adversely impact all HUSD students and staff.

Please spread the word and encourage people to attend the Alameda County Board of Education meeting on Tuesday, May 14th at 6:30pm. We want lots of public comments in opposition to this charter expansion in Hayward!

Mary Walsh and Mercedes Faraj met with the superintendent about attending the meeting and giving a strong message in opposition to the expansion of Hayward Collegiate. The Superintendent is on board.
