Retro-Paycheck Timeline Questions

We have received a lot of questions about the wording on the recent retro-check paystubs and were given clarification again from payroll with the below details:

- June 5 check: 2% for July 2022 April 2024
- May 31 check: 2% for May 2024
- June 6 check: 10.67% for July 2023 May 2024 (When the payroll system calculates, it is saying its 8.5% because it is 8.5% on top of last year's rate of an additional 2% [which is now compounded] totaling 10.67% for this year)
- June 20 check: Retroactive payments for Extra Duty, Summer School, and Appendix A.
- June 28 check: 10.67% raise for June 2024 and adjustments to stipends.

See the attached **Payroll Adjustment and Retroactive Payments Communication** from HUSD Business Services about the compounded pay from the recently ratified contract, paycheck timeline, and FAQ's.

Summer Differed Pay will be issued on July 8[.]!
